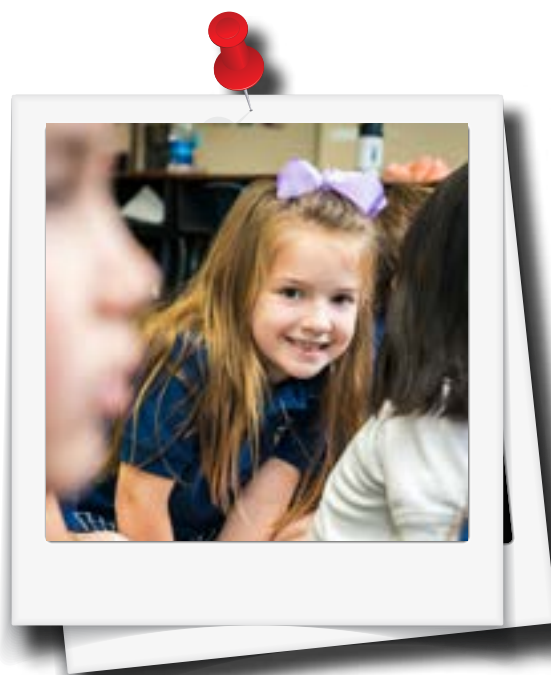

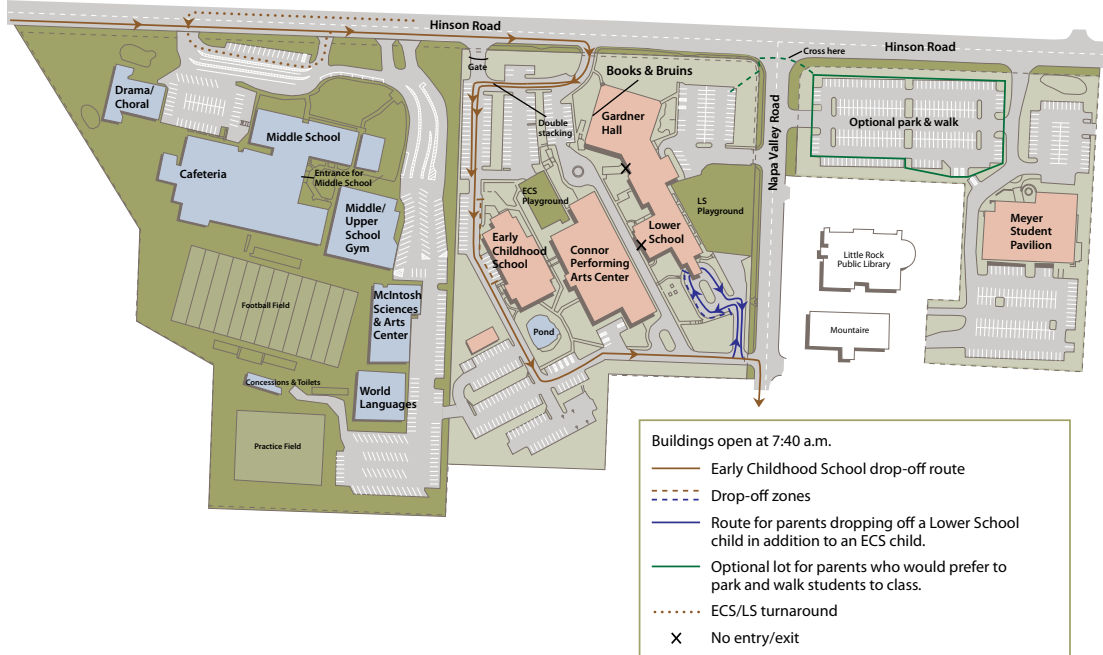




Campus Maps and Traffic Patterns

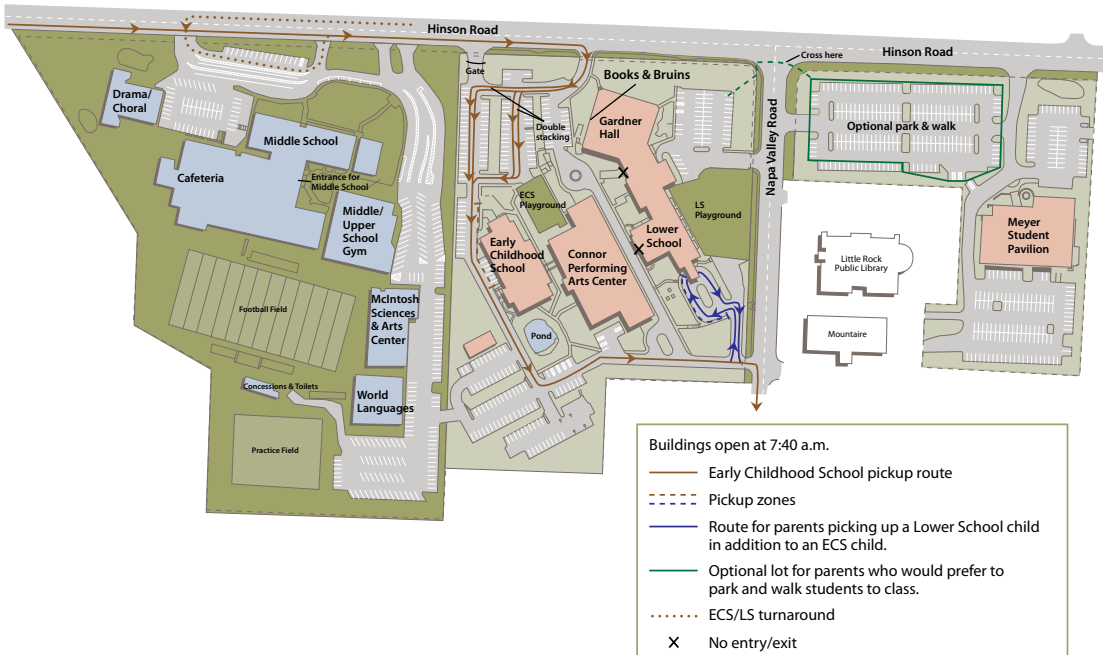
Early Childhood School - Drop-off

Early Childhood and Lower School children will not be allowed to walk from one division to another unless accompanied by an adult.



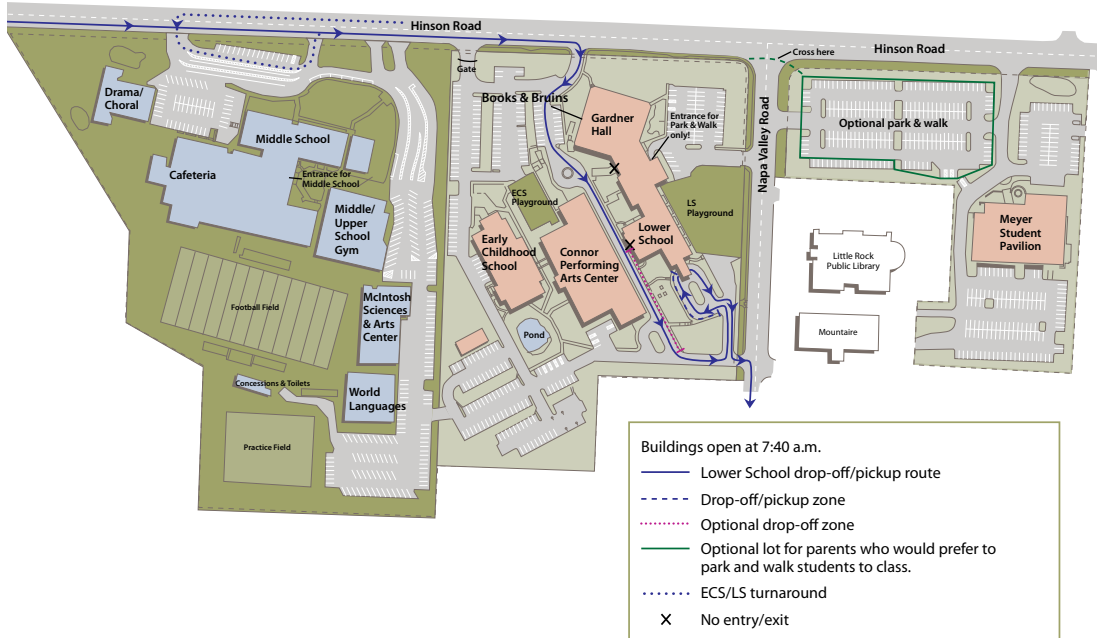
Early Childhood School - Pickup

Early Childhood and Lower School children will not be allowed to walk from one division to another unless accompanied by an adult.

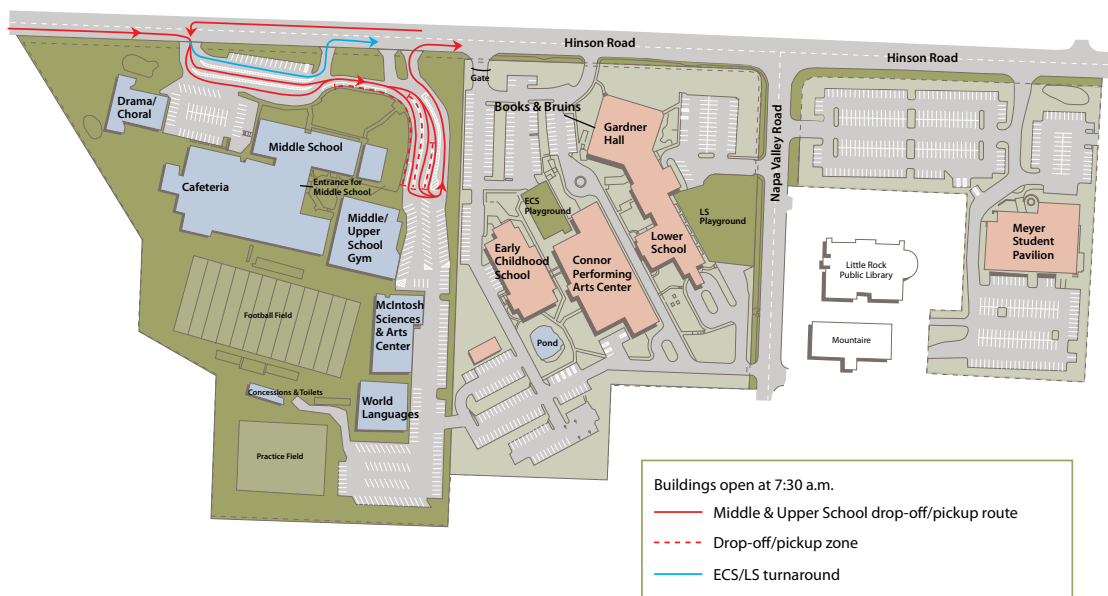


Lower School - Drop-off/Pickup

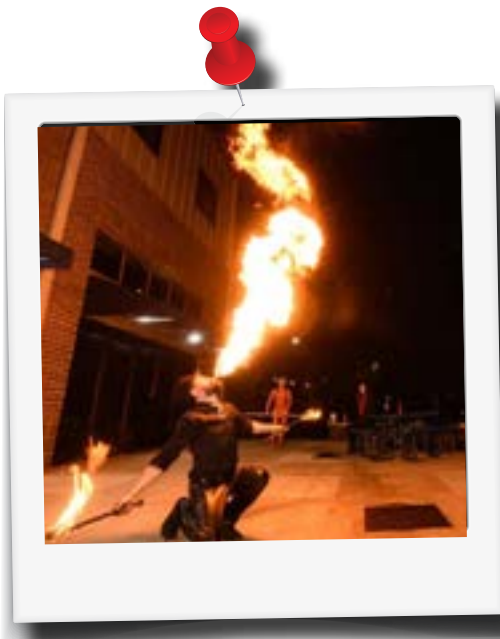

Immunizations

Arkansas State law requires all students to provide documentation of required immunizations or a current immunization exemption letter from the Arkansas Department of Health. Documentation of either must be provided by the first day of school in August. Students will not be permitted to attend school or school activities until proper documentation is obtained.

All students who meet the following age and/or grade criteria below will require the immunizations listed.

Kindergarten

DTaP	4 doses, with 1 on/after 4th birthday
Polio	3 doses, with 1 on/after 4th birthday
MMR	2 doses
Varicella	2 doses

Age 11 or older on/before September 1st

TDap	1 dose
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7th Grade

Meningococcal	1st dose
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Age 16 on/before September 1st

Meningococcal	2nd dose, or 1st dose if missed 7th grade dose
